16. Use Hotel Tonight (www.hoteltonight.com) to find last-minute deals on hotels across the country

17. Rent cars through Costco or AAA. Second driver is free as well as booster seats.

18. Buy yourself a gift card (https://www.mypursestrings.com/buyyourself-gift-card/)

19. Shop the clearance section of stores like Overstock and Wayfair. Open-boxed items come with the same return policy & quality guarantee

20. Broadway and Off-Broadway tickets--use TheaterMania, Broadway Box, or visit the TKTS book (use the app first to see availability). Also, Broadway Roulette--pick a day and time, and they will match you with show tickets, often as low as \$35

21. Paribus--searches for past purchases and if the price drops or gets delivered later than promised, they will get you a refund or credit

22. Honey--a Chrome extension that finds the cheapest price for you while you shop online

23. Buy Refurbished--especially for electronics, this can save you lots of money at Amazon, Apple, Best Buy, and more (https://www.mypursestrings.com/lowest-prices-amazon-electronics-echo/)

24. Facebook Events--search Facebook for free events to do with the family.
